Abstract submission

ABSTRACT	It is not compulsory to submit an abstract.
PREFERENCE	If you are submitting an abstract, please remember to complete all the fields, including your preference (oral/poster).
ORAL OPTION	Short talks will be selected among the submitted abstracts. A small number of abstracts will be selected for short talks by the organizing committee. A selection process will take place to announce result up to 2 weeks after the abstract submission deadline. Abstracts that are not selected for a short oral presentation may still be accepted for presentation in the poster session.
POSTER OPTION	Posters should be placed upon arrival according to the abstract numbers placed on the boards. Please bring a printed copy of your poster, maximum A0 size portrait format. First authors are requested to stay next to the poster during the poster sessions, this will give participants a chance to present their posters to the speakers.

Abstract Awards

- No abstract will be reviewed if payment has not been made.
- Awards may be given to a maximum of three short talks (250* € each) and a maximum of three posters (170* € each). The awards will be given at the end of the conference, the prize winners must be present. Awards will be effective through bank transfer. The prizes may be declared void. *Taxes will be applied depending on their residence status.

- Participants are expected to book and pay their own accommodation and travel expenses.
- CNIO reserves the right to close registration and abstract submission when we reach full capacity.
- The official language of the conference is English. No simultaneous translation will be provided.
